Poor control of air and water temperature? Recotherm Aeris D provides a solution



Recotherm were recently called in to help improve the pool hall conditions at this Cambridgeshire golf club.

The existing unit which was a Calorex Delta was struggling to hold both the air and water temperatures in the hall. The decision was taken to replace the unit and if they were going to spend thousands of pounds why not upgrade to a Recotherm 'controlled fresh air unit' at the same time.

The Aeris D Recotherm model

This is a remove and replace unit specifically designed to be a direct replacement for Calorex Delta or Heatstar product. We are increasingly finding that a lot of existing units installed in hotels and leisure centres are not performing well after 5-10 years service and that the Aeris D is a suitable replacement due to its compatibility.

The Aeris D has the same connections and is an easy-fit solution for those who wish to upgrade, with the minimum amount of disruption in the plant room.

In Bourne Gols case the access to the plant room was good, so for once there was no need for Recotherms celebrated flat-packing and this speeded up the installation time. The job was started on the Monday and the unit was commissioned and fully running by Friday of the same week.



The client also took advantage of an offer on the 'Scent solution' option. This is an integrated system that disperses a wide range of selected aromas such as alpine air, apple fresh, bergamot, citrus, cherry blossom, cinnamon, jasmine, lavender, fresh flowers, mint, lemongrass, ocean breeze, orchid, rose, sea scent, vanilla to name but a few. It can be sited within the main plant or externally to provide fragrances that make the pool hall experience more like an expensive spa.



It is a bespoke system of pump, diffuser and control technologies that diffuses aromas. This involves 'Cold Air Diffusion', which in simple terms, pressurises liquid aromatic oil and releases it as a gas, through the diffuser, these droplets are so small they do not condense - which could damage walls - and users cannot feel them when they breath it in, thus making the space feel that it has a natural scent.

The diffuser can be set up to operate continually or for just a few hours a day by utilising the built in scent time clock and the intensity of the fragrance can be adjusted by using the 'scent intensity' control.

So not only does the pool hall feel a lot better it smells better too.
